

Research activities – with curiosity and passion

More than one billion people worldwide are disabled, blind, disfigured, handicapped by neglected tropical diseases. Many of them die as a result. We would very much like to contribute to changing this situation. Many of these diseases can be controlled through appropriate treatment programs and additional research effort. The tropical worm diseases Schistosomiasis and Chagas are poverty-related diseases. Our Institute is intensively dealing with these issues, i.e. carrying out profound research activities and also developing appropriate solutions to meet these medical challenges.
